Step 2 - Parish Priest or Agency Head

Report the matter to the Safeguarding Office

Step 3 - Safeguarding Office to:

Provide advice and support to Parish Priest or Agency Head and Workers regarding reporting to NSW Police and DCJ

If you suspect:

- * Neglect
- *Psychological Harm

Step 1 - Workers to:

Report to the Parish Priest or Agency Head



Step 2 - Parish Priest or Agency Head to:

Report the matter to the Safeguarding Office
