



Background

Sumner House (House) is a young men's house of discernment located at 8 Mills Street, Lidcombe, New South Wales. The House is an initiative of the Archbishop of Sydney, Most Rev Anthony Fisher OP with oversight by the Chancellor and coordinated by the Vocations Centre. Up to eight young men will be accepted as residents of the House, subject to a successful application process.

How to apply to become a resident at the House

Men over the age of 18 years can apply to reside at the House for a period of up to 12 months. The maximum age limit is 30 years. Together with other residents and the House Manager, they will spend the year together to pray, study, and actively discern their vocations.

The application process involves:

- Completing this Application Form and sending to vocations@sydneycatholic.org;
- participating in an interview if you are selected to do so;
- if successful: signing a Resident's Agreement before moving in; and
- attaining working with children check/national criminal history check clearances prior to moving in.

Selection Criteria

Successful applicants will be chosen based on a demonstrated openness to discerning a vocational call; an aptitude for study, work and prayer; a willingness to engage in the faith community; and a level of maturity conducive to living in community.

Decisions and Commitments

All applications will be considered seriously by the Archdiocese. It is important to note, however, that spaces at the House are limited. The Archdiocese at its sole discretion will determine who will be accepted as residents of Sumner House. Successful applicants must agree to comply with rules associated with the residency of the house and will sign an agreement before they take up residency. Time at Sumner House is both a gift and a responsibility. **Residents agree to meet the expectations of the House as part of their stay. These include; Morning Prayer and Holy Hour (6:30am-7:30am Mon-Fri), Brotherhood and Formation (6:30-9:15 pm Tues and Thurs), a monthly retreat/outing (normally a half-day on a weekend), an annual 3-day retreat (Friday evening to Sunday), and duties related to the household roster. (See the Resident's Agreement for a full list of household commitments). Work and study commitments must be held in tandem with the expectations of the house. The House Chaplain can give permission to miss an event for good reason and at his discretion. There are three one-week 'Rest Periods' during the year where house expectations do not apply. The decision of the Archdiocese in relation to applications is final.**

Privacy







WHAT DO YOU HOPE TO RECEIVE FROM YOUR TIME AT SUMNER HOUSE?






SPIRITUAL:


PHYSICAL:
