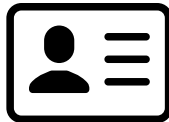

## Activity Choiceboard

### 1. "Deadly" Leaders Profile Sheet

Choose an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander leader, artist, athlete, writer, activist, scientist or musician and create a one-page visual profile with:

- Name
- Country/community, where appropriate
- Key achievements
- Why they are "deadly"
- One quote or fact



### 2. NAIDOC Timeline Strip

On paper or card, create a timeline showing important moments in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander history, NAIDOC Week history, and local milestones.



### 3. Reflection Postcard

Design a postcard with an artwork on the front and a written reflection on the back:

- "One thing I learned..."
- "One thing I respect..."
- "One action I can take..."



### 4. Word Art: "Deadly means..."

Create a visual word cloud around the word DEADLY, using words like strength, culture, pride, survival, language, community, family, justice, truth, future.
